Yamaguchi City Saikoutei



For 120 years from its opening in 1877 until role of Yamaguchi's VIP guest house, watching as the history of modern Japan unfolded. The building was subsequently relocated and restored as Yamaguchi City Saikoutei museum and reception hall. Here you will find displays of artifacts with connections to Yamaguchi, including 29 documents handwritten by public figures, such as Marquess Inoue Kaoru (a senior statesman of the Meiji period) and former Prime Minister Eisaku Sato, You can also enjoy experiencing Japanese culture by kimono wearing experience and tea ceremoney experience.

Ryufukuji Temple

Hanchomon Gate



Built as the main gate to the Yamaguchi Feudal Administration Office when the domain headquarters were relocated from Hagi to Yamaguchi in 1864, this gate measures around 6.8 m high and around 10 m wide and is designated as a Prefectural Important Cultural Property. The side gate on the Feudal Administration Office side is kept pen, allowing visitors to come and go as they please. The main gate maybe specially opened for historical events.


